Annual Asbestos Notification Letter

Dear Parents, Students, and Staff:

Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) in 1986. This act concerns asbestos in schools. As a result of this act, our facilities were inspected for asbestos containing building materials and their conditions assessed. The materials are re-inspected and re-assessed every three years. We continue to monitor the conditions of these materials through our ongoing six-month surveillance program. It is our district's intent to comply with federal, state, and local regulations governing asbestos to ensure a safe environment for our students, staff, and visitors. A copy of our district's Asbestos Management Plan is available at our facilities' administrative offices during regular school hours. 
During the past year, our district has conducted the six-month surveillance.
