I want to share with everyone that we have a very important election coming up on November 2, 2021. In this election we will be electing three school board members to four-year terms. A school board member has an important role in the success of a school district. This is a non-partisan, volunteer position. The reward for being a school board member comes from the opportunity to provide an important service to the community. COVID is always an agenda item and topic at the school. The Delta variant is spreading through our nation and community. We know to stop the spread of the virus you need to stay home when you are ill or infected (sometimes you are infected without symptoms). The school now has saliva test kits we can pass out to families. The kits are free of charge and come with prepaid mailing for you to send the test back to the state hygienic lab. These same COVID saliva tests are available at Test Iowa sites currently. Another excellent tool we have for COVID mitigation is vaccination. Vaccines are readily available at various locations throughout our community for those twelve and older. Universal masking was in place throughout the state last year and did play a role in overall mitigation of the virus. It is still a strong mitigation tool to utilize to help stop transmission of the virus.

Mental Health professionals recognize September as a month for bringing attention to signs to watch out for if a loved one seems to be struggling.

While 1 in 5 people will experience a mental illness during their lifetime, everyone faces challenges in life that can impact their mental health.

Steps to help with mental health:

- 1. Connect with others
- 2. Create Healthy Routines
- 3. Find the Positives
- 4. Eliminate Toxic Influences
- 5. Own Your Feelings
- 6. Support Others

When it comes to diet, sleep and exercise, having good, strong routines is linked to improved mental and physical health.

People with more daily routines have lower levels of distress when facing problems with their health or negative life events.

It takes an average of 66 days for a behavior to become automatic (a habit), but for some people it can take as long as 8 1/2 months. Don't give up!

Help Your Child Succeed in School by building a habit of good attendance early!

Did you know?

- Starting in kindergarten, too many absences can cause children to fall behind in school.
- Missing too many days can make it harder to learn to read.
- Students can fall behind if they miss just one or two days of school a month.
- Being late to school may lead to poor attendance.
- Absences can affect the whole classroom if the teacher has to slow down learning to help children catch up.
- Poor attendance can influence whether children read proficiently by the end of third grade.
- When students improve their attendance rates, they improve their academic prospects and chances for graduating.

Vinton-Shellsburg Schools are working to improve chronic absences by working more closely with families.
