To the Vinton-Shellsburg School Community,

We are (almost) ready to kick-off the 2018-19 school year for students! My heart goes out to the communities west of here that experienced the tornadoes in July. We understand the challenges this creates for students, families, the school district and the community with school starting just around the corner as we had a similar event (on a small scale) on July 17, 2016.

The custodians and painters have done a tremendous job cleaning, updating and getting the buildings ready for the new year. Our maintenance crew has coordinated several jobs with outside contractors to get projects done.

At Tilford, the parking lot on the west side of the building is done plus we have a new sidewalk on the south side of the building that will make things more convenient for some of our older students. At the High School, we replaced the lights in the gym with more energy efficient ones plus we refinished the floor and had the lines repainted. At the Middle School, we installed new carpet in the library and are in the process of replacing the outside walk-in freezer with a more modern cooler/freezer inside the building. At Shellsburg, we have repainted the floors and updated two of the restrooms. At the bus barn, we installed more cement outside of the buildings. At the Karr Athletic Complex, we now have a sidewalk to the visitors' bleachers plus a better place for our band trailer to park.

Our staffing is in place as our principals finalized the new teachers who will be a part of our district as well as associates. There will be some new faces in our food service program along with those that are returning, everyone is returning on our central office staff, the secretaries in the buildings, the custodians and maintenance and our bus drivers! Many of our teachers have completed additional classes during the summer so they are better prepared to meet our students' needs. We are finalizing the professional development activities for our teachers in August before students return. We recently finished summer school that assisted our students either in staying caught up with their academics or helping them to catch-up with credit recovery.

For the third year, we offered a summer breakfast and lunch program at Shellsburg and Tilford where all children could eat for free. I recently stopped in and it was great to see all the students who came to eat as well as the high school students who were volunteering for Black and Gold hours!

We will have our annual school sale on Tuesday, August 7th from 11:00-6:00 pm. We will have old desks, chairs, and file cabinets for sale as well as some used sound equipment, DVD players and other miscellaneous.

VINTON-SHELLSBURG REGISTRATION

All registrations will be done via the PowerSchool program again this year. If you choose to come to the Registration Day on August 6, there will be staff available to assist you in the registration process.

RevTrak will be the preferred use of payment for online registration. There will NOT be a convenience charge again this year for anyone that eRegisters AND pays online via RevTrak through August 6, 2018. If you so choose to pay by check or cash, you will need to come to Registration Day at the High School on August 6th, 12:00pm—7:00pm to pay your registration fees. **NOTE: Textbook fees must be paid prior to activity passes being issued. If you were invoiced for computer damage or loss for the 2017-18 school year, payment is due at this time.** Online fees will be for full price only, no waived amounts will be offered. If you believe you qualify for free and reduced fees then you will need to attend Registration Day and complete the paperwork to see if your family qualifies. You won't be able to pay online, but you will still be required to complete the eRegistration process online.

Options for registration include:

- ◆ You can eRegister online, but pay at school;
- ◆ You can eRegister and pay full price on-line with a credit /debit card;
- ◆ You can come in and complete eRegistration and payment at the high school on August 6.

New Students to District

Elementary Students: Parents should come to registration day August 6th at the high school to begin the process of registering your child(ren).

Middle School: Parents should come to registration day August 6th at the high school to begin the process of registering your child(ren).

High School: New students to the district may contact the guidance office (436-5704) beginning August 9th to schedule an appointment for registration with their counselor.

Appointments will be scheduled between August 13th and 17th so that all new students will be enrolled in their courses by the first day of school.

VARIED CLASS SCHEDULES FOR AUGUST 23RD

Vinton-Shellsburg **Grade 1-12 students** will have classes August 23rd, but will be on a **2-Hour Early Dismissal** Schedule.

Kindergarten students don't have school on August 23 & 24. Kindergarten students and their parents will have scheduled parent conferences where students can bring their school supplies and teachers will share information about the school year and answer questions. Parents can sign up beginning July 20th online following the links at the Tilford Elementary and Shellsburg Elementary websites.

Kindergarten starts August 27th.

Tiny Vike's Preschool starts August 29th. Teachers will contact parents to set up home visits.

It is also important to note that there **will NOT** be free school supplies offered in district this year. School Packs are offered at www.EducationalProducts.com/ShopPacks. Enter our School ID (Shellsburg-SHE197; Tilford-TIL020), then click the Enter button. Choose a grade level and have it shipped to your home.

SCHOOL PERMIT INSTRUCTIONS

Students who are interested in applying for a School Permit can stop at the high school office during registration or contact the high school office to arrange an appointment time with Mr. Islas to get the necessary signature.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

An immunization record is required for everyone attending public or non public schools.

Elementary/secondary requirements: Dtap-5 doses; Polio-4 doses; MMR-2 doses; Hepatitis B-series of 3; Varicella-2 doses or history of Chicken pox. **Kindergarten requirements:** Lead screen, Vision screen, and Dental screen. **Third grade:** Vision screen.

7th Grade: The Iowa Department of Public health is now requiring that all 7th graders receive a booster of tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis (Tdap) It is recommend that students in the higher grades receive a booster of Tdap. **9th Grade:** Dental screen

If your student has not received the required booster please do so before the school year starts. If you have any questions or concerns feel free to contact the school nurse at 319-436-4728 or Kristin.hallberg@vscsd.org. Our school district is required to have a current immunization record or an exemption for every student . The IDPD audits this every year.

School officials cannot allow your child to enter school unless the child has a completed certificate of immunization or an exemption on file. Please bring the completed immunization certificate or exemption when registering your child.

Medication Policy

It is the policy of the Vinton-Shellsburg Community School District that whenever a student has medication, prescription or otherwise, that is to be administered by school personnel, written authorization and instruction must be provided by a parent or legal guardian. **Medication release forms are also available in each nurse's office. No Medication will be given WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION. This includes ASPIRIN, ANT-ACIDS and COUGH DROPS.** Only the school nurse or trained personnel will administer the medication upon request of the parent. The medication must be in the **original container**, stating the child's name, name of the medication, the time medication is to be given and the dosage. Students who have demonstrated competence in administering their own medications **may administer their medication when a written statement by the student's parent** is on file requesting co-administration of the medication when competence has been demonstrated. By law, students with asthma or other airway constricting diseases may self-administer their medication upon approval of their parents and prescribing physician regardless of competency.

ANNUAL NOTICE OF OPEN ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES

Following are highlights of the open enrollment procedures as mandated by the Iowa Legislature. This information does not cover the entire open enrollment legislation. **Non-kindergarten filing deadline is March 1st** and **kindergarten filing deadline is September 1st**. Parent/guardian must file Open Enrollment forms with **BOTH** the receiving district **AND** the resident district. The **RECEIVING** district approves or denies the application. The exception to this rule is if the **RESIDENT** district has a desegregation plan in place or a claim of pervasive harassment or serious health condition the resident district must act upon the application first.

2019-2020 Deadlines Timeline / Procedures

- **Before March 1, of the Preceding School Year:** Parent/Guardian sends application to **BOTH** the resident and receiving districts. If the student is entering kindergarten, the application may be made after March 1 until the deadline of September 1.

Parents should be aware that open enrollment may result in the loss of athletic eligibility at the varsity level of competition for the first 90 school days of open enrollment. A separate form must be completed for each pupil requesting open enrollment. In most instances, a parent requesting open enrollment is responsible for providing transportation for the open enrolled student. However, if your family income falls within the Federal poverty guidelines you are eligible for financial assistance for transportation purposes. - **September 1:** Deadline for Kindergarten.
- **“Good Cause” Exception to March 1 Deadline:** Applications may be approved after the March 1 deadline if the reason for late filing qualifies for “good cause.”

Students who purchase an activity ticket during registration will receive a Red colored ID card the first day of school as long as required fees and all other overdue fees are paid in full. Those students who do not purchase an activity ticket will receive the usual Gold ID card. Should you purchase an activity ticket later, you will need to turn in your Gold ID card and you will be issued a Red ID card as long as required fees and all other overdue fees are paid in full. There will be a \$5 replacement charge for ID's if you should lose them and need another one reprinted.
